Grade 1

I am always well prepared for lessons – I arrive on time, my homework is completed and I have all the books and equipment I need. I take an active role in lessons, putting my hand up to answer questions and contributing to group discussions. I always complete work to my personal best and meet deadlines. My behaviour is excellent, enabling me and others in my class to learn and make progress.

Grade 2

I am usually prepared for lessons and participate when I can. I usually complete work to my personal best and meet deadlines. My behaviour is good, enabling me and others in my class to learn and make progress.

Grade 3

I am not always prepared for lessons – I sometimes arrive late, my homework is not always done and I do not always have the books and equipment I need, and sometimes I don't concentrate on my work. I don't always complete work. Sometimes my behaviour disrupts the learning of other people in my class.

Grade 4

I am often not prepared for lessons and because I don't concentrate on my work I rarely finish work in the lesson. Often my behaviour disrupts lessons, affecting the learning of other pupils.
