Tax claimed by The Forest School School Fund

- The Forest School will reclaim 28p of tax on every £1 you gave up to 5 April 2008.
- The Forest School will reclaim 25p of tax on every £1 you give on or after 6 April 2008.
- The Government will pay to The Forest School an additional 3p on every £1 you give between 6 April 2008 and 5 April 2011. This transitional relief for The Forest School does not affect your personal tax position.

In addition if you are a higher rate tax payer, then you can claim further tax relief in your Self Assessment tax return. There are additional personal tax benefits which are detailed in leaflet IR65 which is available from the Inland Revenue.
